

Synopsis

On the occasion of the Centenary of the ICC International Court of Arbitration, the President of the ICC Court will consider the characteristics of arbitral awards in the early days of the Court, the most common issues which arise during the Court's scrutiny of awards and how arbitral awards may be drafted in the future.
